# Day 1

## Arrival in Edinburgh, Scotland (hotel night)

Welcome to Edinburgh, the capital of Scotland and starting point of our expedition. To provide you with more time to enjoy this metropolis rich in history and culture, we've arranged pre-cruise hotel accommodations. Relax and take a stroll through town, enjoying both medieval and classic 18th-century architecture.



# Day 2

## Welcome Aboard!

Enjoy the morning and early afternoon at leisure. Each corner of Edinburgh's old streets opens beautiful unexpected vistas of green hills or a blue flash of the distant sea. In the afternoon, you will be transferred from the hotel to the ship in the nearby Port of Leith. Before dinner, there's time to explore the Sea Spirit, your home-away-from home for the next days.



# Day 3

## Isle of May & Bass Rock

Our photo adventures begin with the exploration of two uninhabited islands teeming with wildlife. The Isle of May is a national nature reserve, home to puffins, guillemots, razorbills, cormorants, terns, and seals basking on the shore. You'll also spot historic landmarks like St. Ardin's Chapel and the island lighthouse.

Just across the water rises Bass Rock — home to the world's largest colony of northern gannets. Over 150,000 birds fill the cliffs and skies in one of nature's greatest spectacles.



# Day 4

## Kirkwall, Orkney Islands, Scotland

Step ashore in Kirkwall, the charming capital of the Orkney Islands, where Viking and medieval history still shape the town.

Highlights include the magnificent St. Magnus Cathedral, the Bishop's Palace, and the Earl's Palace.

Our included tour takes you west across Orkney's rolling landscape into the UNESCO World Heritage "Heart of Neolithic Orkney." Pass the Standing Stones of Stenness and visit the Ring of Brodgar, a vast ceremonial stone circle over 4,000 years old. Explore Skara Brae, a prehistoric village revealed from the sand only 150 years ago, offering a fascinating glimpse into life five millennia past.

Return to Kirkwall to tour St. Magnus Cathedral, the Vikings' most enduring legacy on the islands.



Ring of Brodgar — a Neolithic stone circle in Orkney, Scotland, dating to around 2500 BCE.



Skara Brae — a Neolithic village in Orkney, Scotland, built around 3180 BCE, older than Stonehenge.



St Magnus Cathedral — a 12th-century red-sandstone cathedral in Kirkwall, Orkney, built by Vikings.



Inside, St Magnus Cathedral reflect rich Norse and Scottish history.

# Day 5

## Fair Isle, Shetland Islands

Fair Isle has more recorded bird species than anywhere else in Britain. On our island walk, we'll look for puffins, gannets, fulmars, kittiwakes, and skuas — often just a few meters away. The puffin colony alone numbers around 12,000 birds!

With only about 50 residents, Fair Isle offers a warm welcome at the community centre with homemade treats and hot drinks. Don't miss the chance to browse the island's world-famous knitwear and chat with locals about life in this remote haven.



# Day 6-9

## Faroe Islands


Explore the stunning Faroe Islands archipelago, known for its dramatic landscapes, colorful villages, puffins, and traditional turf-roofed houses. Visit Tórshavn, the capital, and Kirkjubøur, the Faroes' historic cultural center. Weather permitting, our expedition team will also seek opportunities to reach remote sites by ship and Zodiacs, including bird cliffs and other natural highlights.



# Day 10

## Seyðisfjörður, Eastern Iceland

Sailing along Iceland's rugged eastern coast, we arrive in Seyðisfjörður — a hidden gem nestled among waterfalls and misty mountains. Its colorful wooden houses, built by XIX-century Norwegian traders, line the peaceful harbor, their reflections shimmering in the still fjord waters.



# Day 10


## Seyðisfjörður, Eastern Iceland

Later, we visit Lake Urriðavatn to soak in a geothermal pool with sweeping views of the lake and surrounding peaks. As warm thermal waters meet the crisp mountain air, you'll feel a close connection with Iceland's raw and untouched beauty.





Experience the age-old Icelandic tradition of soaking in a natural geothermal pool at Vök Baths, set on the shore of Lake Urriðavatn.



# Day 11

## Djúpivogur, Eastern Iceland

We anchor near the peaceful fishing village of Djúpivogur, surrounded by rugged cliffs and calm fjords. A guided walk takes us along black-sand beaches and quiet lagoons, where puffins, Arctic terns, and other seabirds can be spotted. We explore small islands linked by natural sandbars, visit a traditional birdwatching hut, and enjoy the gentle rhythm of village life — a perfect way to experience Iceland's serene coastal beauty.






# Day 12

## Vestmannaeyjar Archipelago, Southern Iceland

The volcanic Westman Islands are among Earth's youngest landscapes, shaped by recent eruptions, dramatic cliffs, and thriving seabird colonies. On Heimaey, we see the impact of the 1973 Eldfell eruption, which buried part of the town in ash, and explore the Eldheimar Museum, where interactive exhibits bring this event to life.





The Eldheimar Museum brings the 1973 Eldfell eruption to life through immersive exhibits and preserved remains of the buried town.



# Day 13

## Snæfellsnes Peninsula, Western Iceland

Often called “Iceland in Miniature,” the Snæfellsnes Peninsula captures all the island’s magic in one place — dramatic cliffs, black-sand beaches, lava fields, glaciers, and volcanic craters.

We’ll pass waterfalls and the famous Kirkjufell Mountain, known to Game of Thrones fans as the “Arrowhead Mountain,” with every view revealing a touch of Iceland’s mystical soul.




# Day 14

## Reykjavík — Disembarkation




