eather in July and August can be hot and sticky in much of the U.S., so it's a good time for a cool-weather getaway — somewhere like, say, the Arctic. Poseidon Expeditions is offering expedition cruises to Franz Josef Land, an area of the Russian High Arctic that's seldom visited and, due to ice, is accessible for only a few weeks each year. The archipelago of 191 uninhabited islands is part of the Russian Arctic National Park. Poseidon has two sailings in July and August from Longyearbyen, Norway, aboard the MV Sea Spirit, whose all-suite accommodations can hold up to 114 passengers. Among wildlife that may be seen are polar bears, walruses and endangered bowhead whales. On the way back to Longyearbyen, the cruise also will explore the Spitsbergen archipelago. The two sailings are priced from \$7,295 per person, double occupancy. Reservations also are being taken for the 2017 voyages, which will be priced from \$8,995,

with an early bird discount on one for \$8,096. Info: http://tinyurl.com/z2205e2

# Classic camper vans
